Update on Church Response to COVID-19

all regular in-person church activities and services remain suspended until further notice

In these challenging times, we are attempting to balance the need and desire to gather as a church family with the concerns of putting one another at risk. We have not yet resumed in-person worship due to several concerns:

- Cases of COVID-19 in South Carolina are currently trending upward.
- Indoor church services are considered a “high risk” activity.
- Many in our church family are in the “high risk” category for complications of COVID-19.

Sanctuary Open for Prayer TODAY

We will be opening the sanctuary for prayer ***with safety precautions in place*** on **Sunday, June 28 from 10 am to noon**. Please note that we will ask all attendees to adhere to safety precautions, including:

- sanitizing hands before entering
- wearing a mask (masks will be provided if needed)
- remaining at least 6 feet away from those outside of your family/household
- entering/exiting through specified doors to limit traffic
- limiting the number of people in the sanctuary at a time

These precautions are meant to maintain as safe of an environment as possible for everyone while making the sanctuary available for those for whom being in the sacred space of the sanctuary would be meaningful.
