

Update from CBF on Disaster Response in Lebanon

The Cooperative Baptist Fellowship has provided \$5,000 in emergency assistance to support relief efforts following the August 6 explosion in Beirut, Lebanon, which killed more than 135 people, injured 5,000 and displaced at least 300,000.

CBF field personnel Chaouki and Maha Boulos, who are based in Beirut and were not harmed by the explosion, will lead the relief efforts. The Bouloses reported that immediate needs include food, medicines, toiletries, cleaning supplies, mattresses and bedding. Financial assistance for utilities (electricity and water) as well replacing broken windows are two additional significant needs.
